David Loda, formerly from Seymour, (Humphreysville) CT, spent twenty-three years first in the Army and later the Naval Reserve, retiring as a pilot and Naval War College War Gaming staff in 2004 with the rank of Commander. David is a

member of the Brigade of the American Revolution (BAR) and participates in large scale reenactments.

In his spare time, David is restoring an 18th century house in Bolton, CT (1720) and has expanded his knowledge on the trade of timer framing.
